

LEFA PROGRAM

The Law Enforcement First Aid program is designed to be delivered and taken by law enforcement officers.



The course combines:

- Standard first aid content.
- Medical first responder content.
- Tactical combat casualty care content.

LEFA prepares officers to handle first aid situations they may encounter while on duty.

LEFA CERTIFICATIONS

Law Enforcement First Aid offers three certification options:

- LEFA Dual
- LEFA Single
- LEFA Tactical

Each certification option includes:

- Minimum of 4 hours of scenario-based learning.
- Opportunity for participants to apply their skills.
- Skilled instructor with law enforcement background.
- Appropriate reference materials and props.

Content Summary	Delivers a standard first aid course through a law enforcement lens. Intended for officers who require a first aid certification in addition to LEFA.	Builds on the content of the standard first aid course, and offers LEFA content, as well. Intended for officers who already have a first aid certification, or who need to renew an existing certification.	Focuses on providing first aid in a tactical situation. The course is structured around life-saving interventions and evacuations, while dealing with an active threat. Intended for members of tactical teams and can be part of an annual refresher of IARD skills.
